Supplementary Regulations

1. Title & Authority

The meeting shall be known as the "Historic Myrning Car Sprint" (hereinafter referred to as 'the meeting') and shall be a "Multi-Club Single Car Sprint", conducted under the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations, and any further regulations issued. CAMS Permit Number 317/0904/02
The event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found at www.cams.com.au

2. The Promoters

The promoter will be the Austin 7 Club Inc. Victoria PO Box 462, Moorabbin VIC 3189. The organising committee shall be comprised of members of the Austin 7 Club Inc. Victoria.

4. The Course

The meeting will be held on Korobeit Road approximately 1.5 Kms north-west of Myrning Village. The road is bitumen and rises uphill to crest, with a finish line in a dip. The timed portion of the road is 850 metres long, with the width of 6 metres and a rise of approximately 60 metres.

5. Insurance

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au

6. Further Supplementary Regulations

The promoters reserve the right to issue further regulations, which shall have the same effect as these regulations.

7. Cancellation & Amalgamation

The promoters reserve the right, in accordance with N.C.R. 59, to abandon, cancel or postpone the meeting, if there are insufficient entries, or if the conditions render the course unsafe.

8. Licences & Log Books

Drivers and competitors are required to hold a CAMS Level 2S Licence or higher. CAMS Licence, competition record, club membership card and CAMS Log Book (if issued) must be presented at scrutiny.

9. Protests

Any protest entered must be in accordance with Part XII of the N.C.R.'s and be accompanied by the appropriate fee.

10. Opening & Closing of Entries

Entries will be received by the Secretary of the Meeting, Mr David Lowe, from **Monday, 6 February 2017**, and will close on **Monday 27 March 2017 - No late entries accepted.**

10a. Entries will only be accepted from members of clubs affiliated with CAMS in Victoria.

Production Sports Cars 1941-1975, Touring Cars 1941-1969, and Reproduction Sports Cars & Specials to 1975 period (visual) will only be accepted by invitation.

Sports & Touring Cars must be road registered (red plate accepted.).

Only front-engined racing cars accepted. Rear-engined Production Sports Cars at the discretion of the organising club.

11. Refusal of Entry

The promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry, subject to the provisions of NCR83.

13. Multiple Entries

Multiple entries will be accepted at the discretion of the organising club.

14. Selection of Entries

All vehicles must comply with Schedules A and B of the current CAMS Manual and those entered in a historic category must also comply with the relevant regulations for that group (please refer to the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport). The maximum number of entries shall be 100, and the promoters reserve the right to select entries from those offered in excess of this number in their absolute discretion. All entries are accepted at the discretion of the organising club.

15. Awards

There will be awards for the 1st & 2nd place in each class and for the outright fastest time of day.

16. Vehicle Numbers

Preference for competition numbers may be indicated on the entry form, but the promoters reserve the right to allocate a competition number to each entry. Numbers affixed to cars must comply with General requirements, Schedule K of the current CAMS Manual. Numbers will be available at the Race Control.

17. Clothing

(1) Safety helmets, complying with AS1698, or as otherwise listed in Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual are mandatory.

(2) Drivers are required to wear non-synthetic clothing, which fully covers the body, from neck to wrists and ankles (minimum requirement).

18. Refuelling

The refuelling of cars will be carried out only in the allotted area as marked on Event Plan in the presence of a Fire Officer. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.

19. Fire Extinguishers

All cars shall carry a fire extinguisher in a properly charged condition, which complies with AS1841, except AS1841-2. (900g min. cap.) Refer Schedule H of the current CAMS Manual.

20. Scrutiny

Scrutiny commences at 8.30am, Sunday, 9 April 2017, at the competitor form up area in Korobeit Road. Competitors are reminded that vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

21. Drivers briefing

For all competitors: will be held near Race Control for all competitors at 9.00 am – All drivers must sign on. Those who do not attend drivers briefing will incur a fine of \$50-00 and may be liable for exclusion

22. Practice

A practice run for each competitor will commence at 9.15am.

23. Timing

A timed practice run and three official runs will be staged. The Timekeeper is deemed to be Judge of Fact.

24. Tyre Warming / Burn-outs

Tyre warming before the start line is prohibited, and is only allowed with Race Starter's permission, between the start line and false start line.

25. Speed Limit in Pits

Competitors are required to observe a 5 KPH limit in the Pit Area, and to drive with caution on the grass surface.

26. Anti Doping Policy

Any holder of a CAMS Competition' or Officials licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website.. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS Competition' or Officials licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedures for Breath Alcohol Testing.

27. OH&S Policy & Safety Plan – OH&S Policy & Safety Plan will be displayed at Race Control.

28. Cancellation

The Promoter reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event in accordance with NCR59.

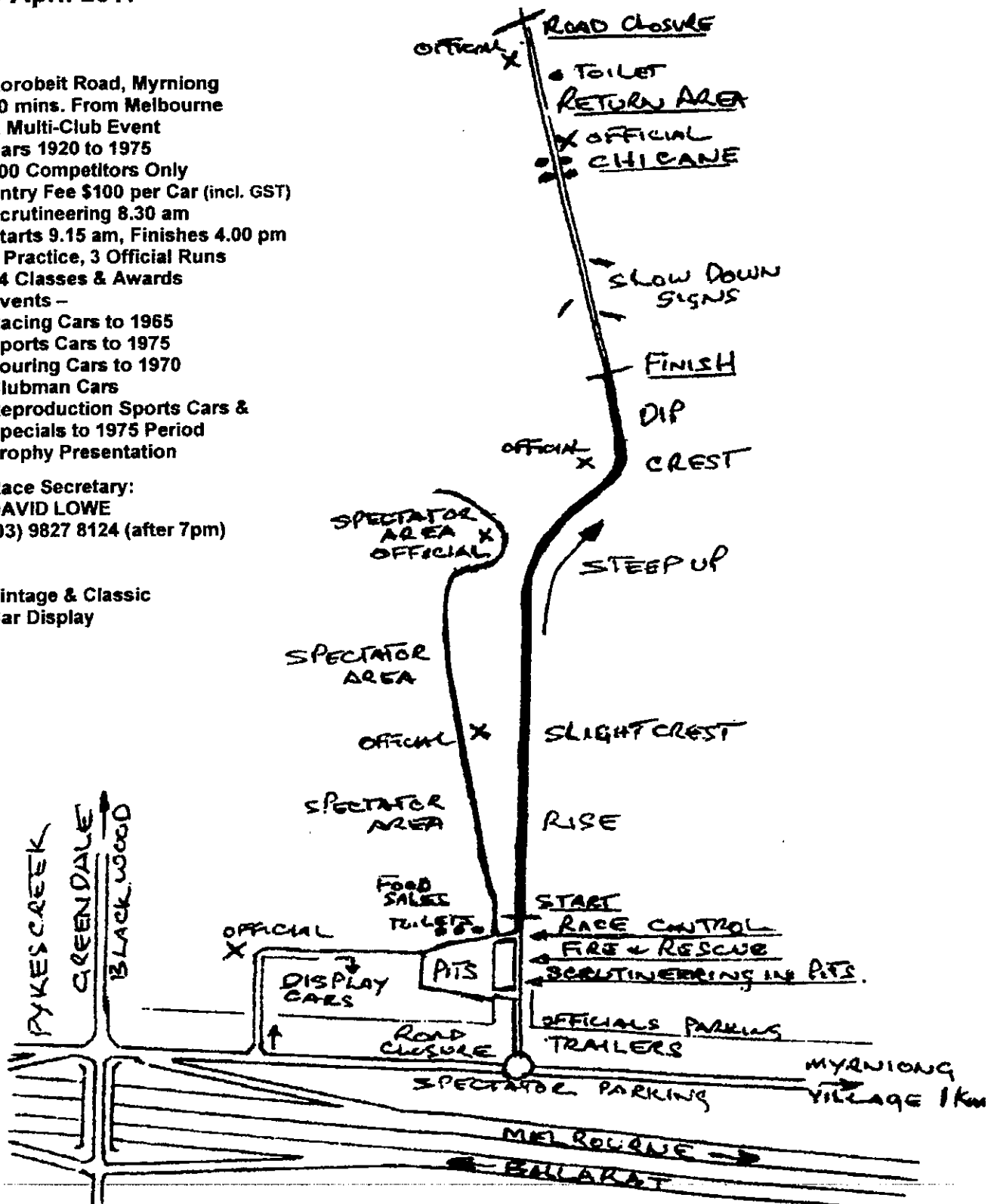

The 850-metre sprint, rising 60 metres, has a level start, rising to a slight crest, rising to a steep uphill right curve, followed by a crest turning left, down a dip and rising to the finish line.
