The annual MG Interclub Challenge is being held in South Australia this year over the Queens Birthday Weekend on June 6 & 7.

It consists of a Hill Climb at Collingrove on the Saturday and a Sprint (run by the MSCA) at Tailern Bend on the Sunday.

Entries for the Sprint have now opened and it is filling rapidly. I know some of you have already entered but for those who were thinking of going and haven't entered yet, now is the time to act.

Entry is via the Motorsport Australia (CAMS) event entry web site.

Apparently the entry web site will be off line from 5 PM today until the 17th presumably for scheduled maintenance etc.

When entering you tick the box that says MG Interclub Challenge with \$0 entry fee. This will get you a spot in the field which has an entry limit of 160 cars.

At a later point in time we will be asked to enter the Collingrove Hillclimb and it is at that point that you will be asked to pay the entry fee. The fee for the combined events (ie. Hill Climb and Sprint is \$350).
